

Oregon White Oak

Oregon White Oak is a classic wood known for its toughness, distinct figure and subtle color. Not your average oak, Oregon White is very similar to French White Oak and gets used frequently in the making of wine barrels and vats.

Quality is our first priority. Our lumber is carefully milled and kiln dried to produce a straight and stress-free floor board. Hand selected for grade, it is then moulded with a low offset tongue and groove for a deeper wear layer. Our mill's technicians maintain precise tolerances throughout the production process to assure a tight, long length, clean fitting floor that makes installation quick and easy.

Grades	<p>SELECT is our finest grade, appropriate for wherever a refined, upscale look is sought. Virtually clear, Select grade does allow for occasional small pin knots and burls.</p> <p>CHARACTER is our very popular appearance grade. This grade highlights the structurally sound natural features of the wood, including knots no larger than 2" in diameter, tight burls, and small fillable holes and checks which will not effect the strength or integrity of the flooring.</p> <p>RUSTIC is our long length grade specifically for our Wide Plank floors. Allows structurally sound larger knots and checks for a more naturally Antique look.</p>
Color & Grain	A uniquely cool toned wood, pale wheat to khaki coloring with warm cream tones. It's distinct, flowing grain, shows a high percentage of rift and quartersawn flecking.

Eco-Status	Northwest Native (ask about FSC certified availability)
Source Region	Best color and quality come from trees native to NW Oregon and Washington
